I would like to share with you some information as we plan for the end of the school year.

**Last Day of Classes:**

- **Friday, May 15:** Senior Class – However, seniors in AP courses will continue to meet until the day prior to the exam being administered.
- **Wednesday, June 10** - Underclassmen

**Final Exams:**

- There will be **no** final exams for any grade level. Even if Bergen Catholic reopens and we return to our school building this year – there will still be **no** final exams administered.

**Grading Calculations:**

**Virtual Learning Grade - Fourth Quarter**

A Virtual Learning Grade is being provided to each student in recognition of the unique effort students must provide to engage with our virtual learning program. Additionally, this grade is designed to take into consideration the stress that the students are under due to the uncertainty of these times.

The virtual learning grade is valued at 5 points and will be applied to each end of the term fourth quarter course grade.

So, for instance:

Fourth Quarter Course Grade	Virtual Learning Grade	End of Term Fourth Quarter Grade
70	5	75
80	5	85
90	5	95

Please note that the highest fourth quarter course grade a student can achieve is a 100. So, if a student has a grade of 97 the virtual learning grade will raise the course grade to a 100 **not** a 102.

**Grading Calculations:**

Due to the elimination of final exams, year-end grading calculations will be as follows:

**Full-Year Courses**

First Quarter:	20%
Second Quarter:	20%
Mid-Term Exam:	10%
Third Quarter:	25%
Fourth Quarter:	25%
Total:	100%

Third Quarter:	50%
Fourth Quarter:	50%
Total:	100%


